This letter is to inform you that the New Mexico Indian Affairs Department ("IAD") has funding available to support the expansion of tribal serving mental and behavioral health services to the Nations, Pueblos and Tribes ("NPTs") in New Mexico by tribal-serving organizations. The application period will open January 30, 2025. Completed applications must be submitted along with a detailed budget and letter of support from the Executive Director of a tribal serving non-profit or for-profit organization.
